



- ◆ Turn the mask right side out through the hole that was left in the top seam.
- ◆ Now is a good time to press the mask with an iron.
- ◆ Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are in the same direction.
- ◆ Stitch along the edge of the mask, all the way around. This will close off the top opening, and will also secure the tucks in place.
- ◆ Tip: On each tuck, it is a good idea to take a few stitches from and back over that tuck to secure them in place.
